How the travel subsidy works

One night hotel will be subsidized, unless 2 nights fall in line with the following pay structure:		
Up to 750km- \$750 max	751-1000 km- \$1000 max	1001 km + -\$1200 max

Treasury Board rates will be used for mileage (\$.53) and the dinner (\$50.00) for our members traveling more than 200 km after the assembly.
For stays of 2 nights, you must pay for your hotel in advance to submit your receipts at the assembly.

- The Citizens Assembly is open to all registered band members of the Wei Wai Kum First Nation.
- Only registered band members will be subsidized.
- If other registered band members are travelling together only one member will receive the subsidy.
- You will receive a travel subsidy claim form at the conference. Original receipts **MUST** be provided at the conference for subsidy.
