Youth Chosen Sport or Activity
Funding Policy

Thunderbird Recreation Chosen Sport or Activity Funding Policy

Registration Fees:

Based on the availability of funds, the Thunderbird Recreation will provide assistance funding for the chosen Sport or Activity's registration fees up to a maximum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per youth per calendar year (September 01 to August 31)

Procedures:

- The parent/guardian must bring in the completed funding application either before or after the start date of the activity.
- The completed funding application must be accompanied by either a receipt and or completed registration form for chosen activity.
- Applications must be submitted before the last Monday of the month in order to be issued a cheque on the last Friday of the month.
- No cheques will be issued without the proper paper work filled out, which includes the funding application, registration forms and or receipts.
- Applicants & or their parents must commit to volunteering at Wei Wai Kum Nations community events, upon the request of the Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC).

Next Level: Provincials or equivalent

Based on the availability of funds, the Thunderbird Recreation will provide assistance funding for those youth that succeed in their chosen Sport or Activity and are selected to participate at the Provincials or equivalent level. The Thunderbird Recreation will assist with travel costs to a maximum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per youth, per activity, per calendar year (September 01 to August 31)

Procedures:

- The parent/guardian must bring in the completed funding application either before the start date of the activity.
- The completed funding application must be accompanied documentation showing the child has been chosen to participate at the Provincial level or equivalent in their chosen activity.
- Applications must be submitted before the last Monday of the month in order to be issued a cheque on the last Friday of the month.
- No cheques will be issued without the proper paper work filled out, which includes the funding application, registration forms and or receipts.
- Applicants must commit to fundraising, volunteering at Wei Wai Kum Nations community events and provide a short report o the committee of their accomplishments, upon the request of the Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC).

Next Level: Nationals or equivalent

Based on the availability of funds, the Thunderbird Recreation will provide assistance funding for those youth that succeed in their chosen Sport or Activity and are selected to participate at the Nationals or equivalent level. The Thunderbird Recreation will assist with travel costs to a maximum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per youth, per activity, per calendar year (September 01 to August 31)

Procedures:

- The parent/guardian must bring in the completed funding application either before the start date of the activity.
- The completed funding application must be accompanied documentation showing the child has been chosen to participate at the National level or equivalent in their chosen activity.
- Applications must be submitted before the last Monday of the month in order to be issued a cheque on the last Friday of the month.
- No cheques will be issued without the proper paper work filled out, which includes the funding application, registration forms and or receipts.
- Applicants must commit to fundraising, volunteering at Wei Wai Kum Nations community events and provide a short report o the committee of their accomplishments, upon the request of the Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC).

Next Level: Exceptional/Gifted Level

Based on the availability of funds, the Thunderbird Recreation will provide assistance funding for those youth that succeed in their chosen Sport or Activity and are selected to participate at the Rep or Competitive level where the training/participation requirements exceed the normal or accepted requirements of their chosen Sport or Activity, the Thunderbird Recreation will assist with costs to a maximum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)per youth, per activity, per calendar year (September 01 to August 31)

Procedures:

- The parent/guardian must bring in the completed funding application before the start date of the activity.
- Parents & youth are required to meet with TREC so that they can jointly work together to plan for their child's financial requirements in the sport and or activity they are excelling in.
- The completed funding application must be accompanied with documentation showing the child has been chosen to participate at the Exceptional or Gifted level or equivalent in their chosen activity.
- Applications must be submitted before the last Monday of the month in order to be issued a cheque on the last Friday of the month.
- No cheques will be issued without the proper documentation, which includes the funding application, registration forms, letter/documentation reflecting additional/advanced participation requirements, and or receipts.
- Applicants must commit to fundraising, volunteering at Wei Wai Kum Nations community events and provide a short report to the committee of their accomplishments, upon the request of the Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC).

Team Funding Application:

The Thunderbird Recreation will assist with Tournament Entrance Fee funding to teams that have a minimum of fifty percent (50%) of Wei Wai Kum youth on the team that are looking to participate in a maximum of Two (2) Tournaments per calendar year (September 01 – August 31)

Procedures:

- The team Coach must fill out an application form and submit the tournament registration forms.
- There must be a list of all of the Wei Wai Kum participants.
- The TREC Release and Indemnity form must be completed and signed by the parent(s) for each Child that is participating.
- Applications must be submitted before the last Monday of the month in order to be issued a cheque on the last Friday of the month.
- Teams must commit to fundraising, volunteering at Wei Wai Kum Nation's community events and provide a short report to the committee of their accomplishments, upon the request of the Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC).
- No cheques will be issued without the proper paper work filled out, which includes the funding application, registration forms and or receipts.

Travel Assistance Funding:

Based on the availability of funds, the Thunderbird Recreation will provide travel assistance funding amount of Two Hundred (\$200.00) per youth per calendar year (September 01 to August 31). Proof of registration in a sport/activity is required.

Role & Responsibility of Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC):

TREC is responsible to review completed application at the monthly Thunderbird Recreation Executive Committee (TREC) meeting held on the last Monday of each month and respond to the applicant no later than the last Friday of each month. (Exceptions can be made in the event of short time lines when reaching a next level—Provincials, Nationals, Rep or Competitive level).

MOTION: To amend the Registration Fees Assistance funding amount to Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per youth per calendar year(Sept-Aug). Proof of registration in a sport/activity required. Effective from September 1, 2019.
